



GUIDELINES

BEING APART OF A GROUP—Successful group travel is dependent upon considerate, unselfish behavior by all members of the group

PUNCTUALITY—Every tour, your AWG Representative will outline planned activities. All participants should take careful note of the scheduled and always be on time. This is particularly important on the morning of travel days---a late start may prevent you and your group from seeing and doing everything you'd hoped.

NEATNESS—All participants should keep themselves and their belongings clean and orderly. Be considerate—don't leave your hotel room or the sightseeing bus in disarray.

MEETING OTHERS—Depending on the size of your group, you may be traveling with students and group leaders from other schools and areas. Getting to know them will be an added bonus of your educational tour.

LISTENING—Listen carefully to all instructions you receive from your group leader, AWG Director, volunteers, chaperones, other guides and teachers.

REGULATIONS

All scheduled activities are obligatory. A participant unable to attend due to a physical ailment must inform his or her group leader.

If students wish to visit friends or relatives in a destination country, the group leader must be informed before the tour begins. Upon request, AWG will provide a special form to be completed by parents, giving authorization for such visits. The form is to be submitted to the AWG Director upon arrival.

Visitors or group members of the opposite sex are not permitted in student's rooms. The group leader and AWG Director will establish the curfew. Students are expected to respect the nightly curfew for their own safety and security. Inform student that room checks each night will be conducted.

Smoking is not allowed on buses, during meals in hotel rooms or in any other enclosed space.

Hitchhiking and the driving or renting of any motor vehicle are strictly forbidden for all students

Shoplifting and the possession of illegal drugs will not be tolerated and are punishable by immediate dismissal from the tour. All costs to return home are at the participant's expense. Should the authorities be involved, participants will be subject to the laws of the country they are visiting.

Participants are required to pay for any phone calls or incidental personal expenses incurred at hotels. These will be payable the evening before departure at each hotel.

Compensation for damage done to hotel rooms or to buses is the responsibility of the participants.

Participants not conforming to any of these regulations risk diplomacy action and possible Dismissal from the tour, returning home at their own expense. This decision is reached in consultation with group leader, the AWG Director, and the student's parents
